

### NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF REGULATION

### UNDER THE MANDATE OF THE NATIONAL ELECTION DIRECTOR

Pursuant to the authority vested upon the Office of the National Election Director, I am proposing the enclosed amendment of regulation to implement Title 9 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated) according to the procedures set forth in Chapter 1 of Title 17 of the FSM Code (Administrative Procedures Act).

Extra copies of the proposed regulation can be obtained from the office of the National Election Director in Palikir, Pohnpei. Any person interested in commenting on the proposed regulation may do so by written submission to:

All written submissions must be received by the Office of the National Election Director within thirty (30) days of the posting of this notice, or no later than December 9, 2020.

This proposed regulation shall take effect on the fortieth day from the date of its posting. Persons affected should assume that this proposed regulation became effective on that date unless they learn otherwise. The actual date of effectiveness will be noted on the certified copy of the permanent regulation to be filed pursuant to 17 F.S.M.C. §103(1).

The proposed effective date of this amendment of regulation shall be on December 11, 2020.

Re: Request for Amendment to FSM Rules and Regulations Governing National Elections and PL 14-76 Section 605

### Dear President Panuelo:

This is to follow up and confirm our current meeting regarding the need to amend the existing FSM Rules and Regulations Governing National Elections. Additionally, I am requesting the assistance of the Department of Justice to review Public Law No. 14-76, Section 605 relating to the possibility of terminating special polling places in Guam and Honolulu due to COVID-19 pandemic.

The FSM Permanent Rules and Regulations Governing National Elections was promulgated in 2009. The current rules and regulations is 11 years old, thus, necessary to align compensation of election workers to the current cost of living. Therefore, we are requesting the following amendments:

#### Section 3.6: Compensation of Election Workers:

The uniform rate of compensation for all FSM election workers shall be as follows:

(a)	Local Election Board Members	\$35 per day to \$60 per day
(b)	Central Counting and Tabulating Committee members	\$50 per day to \$75 per day
(c)	Local Counting and Tabulating Committee Members	\$35 per day to \$60 per day
(d)	Short Term Staff	\$20 per day to \$50 per day
(e)	Boat Drivers and Vehicle Drivers	\$35 per day to \$60 per day
(f)	Clerk Typist in each State (Delet	te as they are now on contract)
(g)	Electoral Aides in each State \$35	50 biweekly to \$375 biweekly
(h)	Administrative Assistant/Clerk (Delet	te as they are now on contract)

(i) Overseas Election Board Members and Counting and Tabulating Committee \$75 per day to \$100 per day

Note: Other sections remain the same

Regarding Public Law No. 14-76, Section 605: Voting absentee ballot at a special Polling Place, I would like to request your assistance in reviewing the language of this public law and make necessary recommendations consistent with Guam and Honolulu orders on social distancing due to COVID-19. Section 605, Subsection (2) states:

(2) Not less than 60 days prior to a general election, or 45 days prior to a special election, the National Election Director shall designate the locations of the special Polling Places provided that, there shall be one special Polling Place in Guam and one special Polling Place in Honolulu and that these shall be the only special Polling Places located outside the Federated States of Micronesia"

My office's recommendation would be to exempt this section of the Public Law during this time of COVID-19. Voters will be required to request absentee filing by mail.
